**MOTLOW BCM ANNUAL REPORT
2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR**

1. Monday lunch – provided by churches from all three supporting associations. All proceeds go to our BCM Student Missions Fund. The average attendance was 75.
2. Wednesday lunch – planned, cooked, and served by the BCM Director. Proceeds go to purchasing food supplies for the next week. The average attendance was 64.
3. Thursday Bible study – this discussion oriented study averaged 14 students each week.
4. ENGAGE 24 – this is a nationwide evangelism emphasis for BCM's. We had an outreach event at our BCM Center that was attended by 33 students in October, 2013.
5. Student missions involvement – We had 12 students involved in short-term missions, and 3 students involved in summer missions.
6. We raised \$4400 for our statewide BCM goal, plus an additional \$11,600 to assist students in going on all of our mission trips.
7. Unity Baptist Church continues to use our building as their ministry site as they continue to raise money to build their first church.
8. We received our official IRS 50(C)3 designation as we completed the transfer of the Motlow property from the TBC to the Baptist Collegiate Ministry of South Central Tennessee.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES OF BCM DIRECTOR

9. In December 2013, I concluded a 9-month interim pastorate at Smyrna Baptist Church in Chapel Hill.
10. Upon invitation, I have preached, taught, or spoken at area churches on 19 additional dates during the 2013-14 school year.
11. In January 2014, I attended and completed the Intentional Interim Certification Training provided by the TBC in Johnson City.
12. Attended many Associational Pastor's Conferences, Executive Boards, and other Associational meetings.
13. Was a conference worker at the TBC Annual Meeting in Chattanooga in November, 2013.
14. I am honored and humbled to be sought out for guidance and counseling by several members of the Motlow faculty and staff, as well as by Motlow students who are not actively involved in our ministry.
